BEATITUDE DEVOTIONALS FOR PRE-K FAMILIES

Hello, Families! These are weekly devotionals on the Beatitudes from Jesus' Sermon on the Mount from Matthew:5. With these devotionals and the accompanying coloring pages Preschool children will begin to understand how to live the Beatitudes.



The First Beatitude

It's good to be needy.

What are some things you need help to do?

Try and do some tricky things, like hop on one foot. Try to reach a cup from a high cabinet. Maybe work on a puzzle. When it isn't possible for a child to do the task alone talk about it being ok to ask for help. In fact, God tells us to ask for His help in the Beatitudes.

Read Matthew 5:3 from the Bible or use the simplified version on the coloring sheet. Then read the parable "Friend at Midnight" from Luke 11: 5-13.

Talk about how in the story someone asked for help. A true friend comes to help. God also is just waiting for us to ask for his help. We can't save ourselves or forgive ourselves. To be best friends with God forever, we have to ask.

Pray to God thanking Him for always answering our call for help. Let him know how very much you love him and want to be part of His kingdom.

When we know we need God, we are happy,
then we will have a home with God.
